The college was established in 1972 and has been rendering services in the field of Arts, Commerce and Science at Graduation level, M.A. English, Political Science and Economics at PG level and at Ph.D. level, it has two programmes in the subject Political Science and Economics. The institution has gone three times through the assessment and accreditation cycles of NAAC and has received B⁺⁺ Grade. The institution has witnessed tremendous change due to the arrival of NAAC in the lives of educational institutes. In the seventh criteria educational assessment system developed by NAAC has given new life to Indian education.
